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## EYFS PLAYGROUND WORK

We are now ready to start developing our playground on Fleeming Road. The company who are called Made from Scratch, will be arriving next week and will begin to transform our playground into a magical space for our children to play in. We are very excited! The design includes lots and lots of planting, boulders, a long, willow arch, a very exciting water feature, a large tepee and an amazing structure for our children to climb over and under.

Below is a section of our playground design. This section will be a very natural area with water, sand, a mud kitchen and a large tipi set in amongst lots of planting.

There will be some disruption to the playground over the next few weeks. However, we think the disruption caused will be worth it as it means the playground will be completed by September. A section of the playground will be fenced off and Reception children will have less space to run around in for the final few weeks of term. However, we are planning to take them into the 'big' playground when possible and staff feel confident that they can adapt slightly what they do so the children do not miss out.

**Children who are in 2JS and 2CF will not be able to access their classroom from the gate in the playground in the morning. Instead, all children in 2JS and 2CF will need to use the gates on the street (where they are collected from) when they are being dropped off.**

As we start this exciting project, we really want to thank everyone who was involved in fundraising over the past two years. This has only been able to happen because of your support and shows what we can achieve together as a community. Now for the next project!



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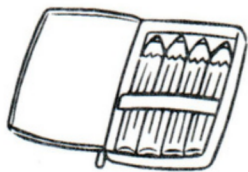
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## NON-UNIFORM DAY FRIDAY 24TH JUNE
