

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CARE ABOUT OUR AIR AND SWITCH OFF YOUR ENGINE



Vehicle Emissions are by far the biggest contributor to air pollution around schools and are a significant health hazard. Children babies are worst affected as they are still developing. It can aggravate conditions like asthma and other lung conditions.
