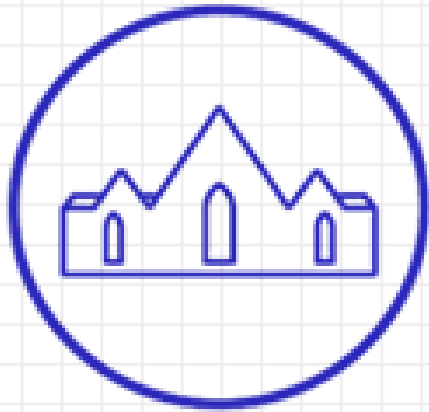

#### ELECTION OF PARENT GOVERNOR

I wrote to you a little while ago asking for nominations from parents who wished to serve on the School's Governing Board.

I have received two nominations and as there is only one vacancy, it will therefore be necessary to hold an election.

1. Each parent is entitled to vote for one candidate.
2. Because ballot papers are being sent electronically via email, there are a number of ways in which you can cast your votes:
  - (a) Email attachment (Word Document)- Please vote by placing an X against the candidate of your choice and returning the Word document to: [forms@winns.waltham.sch.uk](mailto:forms@winns.waltham.sch.uk)
  - (b) Email attachment (PDF Document)- Please print the PDF ballot paper and then vote by placing an X against the candidate of your choice and returning a scanned copy to: [forms@winns.waltham.sch.uk](mailto:forms@winns.waltham.sch.uk)
  - (c) In the body of a return email - Please type the candidate of your choice and place an X against their name.
  - (d) Return a paper copy by hand to the school office - Please print off the ballot paper, place an X against the candidate of your choice. Paper copies can also be collected from the school office. Please ask at the Reception desk. [The voting paper should be sealed in an unmarked envelope which should then be sealed in an outer envelope marked "Parent Governor Elections" and with your name. Once the name has been checked against the list of those eligible to vote, the outer envelope will be discarded and the inner envelope placed in the ballot box].

**It is important that all voters type their full name in the body of their reply email. The school will check their eligibility before saving each ballot separately. If both parents share an email address, type in both names.**

Ballot papers recording more than the required votes or marked in any other way will be invalid.

All voting forms must be returned to the school by **Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> December**. Votes received after this time will be invalid.

You will find enclosed copies of the statements written by the candidates saying why they wish to become parent governors; these may help you to cast your vote/s.
