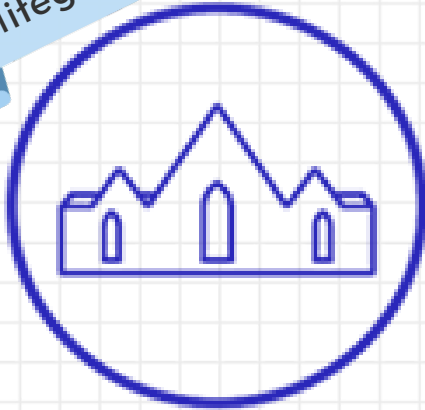

RIGHTS RESPECTING SCHOOLS

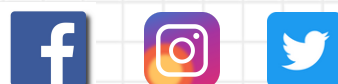
Earlier in the year, we were successful in gaining the Bronze Award of UNICEF's Rights Respecting Schools. This means that the Three Strands of the award have been introduced into school and we are beginning to embed the Rights Respecting program into what we do every day at The Winns.

As part of working towards the Silver Award, we will continue to raise awareness of the program by focusing on an "Article of the Month". This Article will be taken from the United Nations

Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) and will allow us to explore what the Article means in school with the children. We will publish work that links to the Article of the Month, both on our website and in the newsletter. The Article of the Month for January is:
