SAFE STORAGE OF BIKES AND SCOOTERS

Whilst the school is secure, with gates locked at all times, there are points during the day that these are open. We mention this because we heard the sad news this week that one of our Year 6 children had their bike stolen from the school grounds. Whilst this is an extremely rare occurrence, it was nonetheless very upsetting for us. It was an opportunist incident that has been reported to the police. We would urge you to consider using a bike/scooter lock to secure items in the future.
