### **UNIFORM REMINDERS**

#### **Names on School Uniform**

A big, big plea... over the weekend please check that your child has their names on their school jumpers and jackets and as the sun shines, hats and water bottles. Every day the pile of unclaimed school uniform becomes bigger and bigger – nameless jumpers are piled up and we cannot find their owners. Often, we can see the faint pen mark of a name, once there but now washed away. Again and again, children come searching for lost jumpers but in a mass of blue, identical jumpers... it is often futile.

If you are writing your child's name on a school jumper in pen, remember to check it can still be read after it has been washed.

### **School Uniform Policy**

Our school uniform policy states that children wear black shoes or trainers to school. We continue to have a number of children persistently coming to school wearing bright, multi-coloured trainers.
