#### **HER-STORY WORKSHOP**

As part of our work to celebrate Black History Month in school, our year 4 & 5 children have taken part in a workshop exploring the struggles and achievements of historic and contemporary black women from the past 250 years. Through focusing on women such as abolitionist Mary Prince and civil rights activist Rosa Parks, alongside child protestor Ruby Bridges whose rebellious act of simply going to school made her a symbol for the discrimination faced by so many, our children learnt how the actions of women, from Africa and the Caribbean, to America and England, have shaped our history. Or should we say, 'her-story'.









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
#### **OUR VISION IN ACTION**

#### **WORLD MENTAL HEALTH DAY**

We marked World Mental Health Day in school this Tuesday. This year's theme was 'mental health is a universal right'. In school our Emotional Health & Wellbeing Lead, Mr James Baxter, and SENDCO Ms Marta Brusniak work closely with the Waltham Forest Mental Health Support Team. The MHST deliver an early intervention service in school which ranges from 1:1 or group interventions, whole class workshops and staff training. Their aim is to prevent and support with the early identification of mental health difficulties, to improve understanding of mental health and reduce stigma. #### **Dame Sharon White**

Sharon White was a local girl, born in Leyton and attended Cambridge University, studying economics.

She was the first woman of colour to become a Permanent Secretary at the Treasury and played a prominent role in steering the UK through the financial crisis of 2008. She has long been regarded as one of the most influential black figures in the UK.






#### Hello, we're the Waltham Forest Mental Health **Support Team!**

We're an early intervention service based in schools in Waltham Forest. We deliver:

- 1-to-1 interventions for parents
- Group interventions for young people, e.g., transitioning to secondary school
- Whole class workshops, e.g., introduction to mental health
- Staff training





'Why are you called Mental Health Support Team? My child doesn't have Mental Health problems...

We all have mental health, just as we all have physical health. Our mental health is how we're feeling emotionally and it's a bit like internal weather - it can be sunny, rainy or stormy - it's all normal!

Our mental health is just as important as our physical health. It strongly affects our daily lives, including work, study, and how we're getting on with others. Therefore, it is important to take care of our mental health to prevent further problems from arising.







Best care by the best people



We were introduced in schools as the government recognised the need for trained mental health staff to support the whole school community.

Our aim is to prevent and support with the early identification of mental health difficulties, to improve understanding of mental health and reduce stigma.

#### In Primary Schools...

Our 1-to-1 work is with parents where we deliver targeted interventions for children experiencing:

- Anxiety
- Behavioural difficulties

We deliver specific low intensity interventions called Guided-Self Help. These usually last for 6-9 sessions and are based on cognitive behavioural therapy.

#### How can you access our support?

You can contact the school's Mental Health Lead (Mr James Baxter or Ms Marta Brusniak).

After discussing with you, they will support you to fill out a referral form which will be sent to us. We will then be in touch with you within 4 weeks to assess if we are a suitable service for you.
