We are reaching out to those parents who took part in last year's meetings to continue this process and to warmly

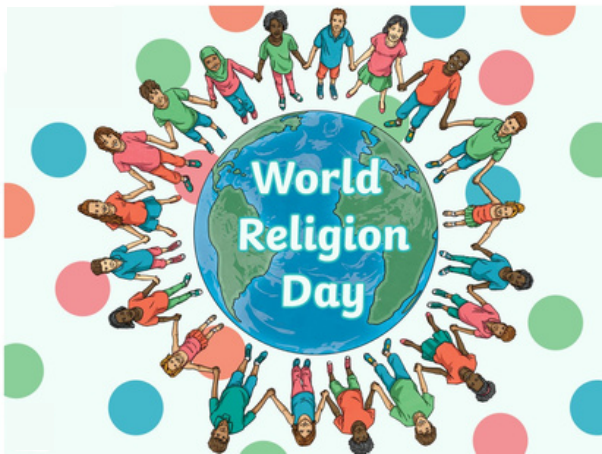

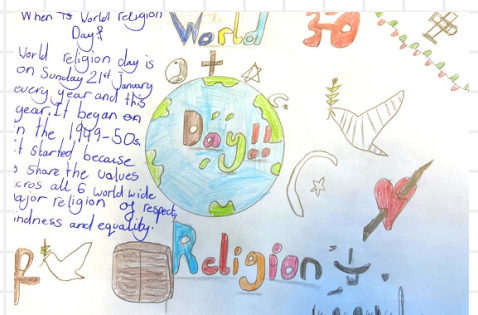
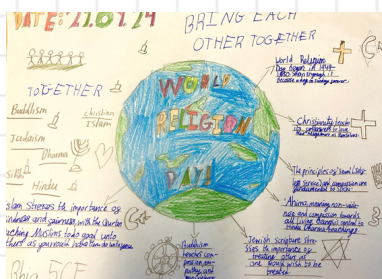
