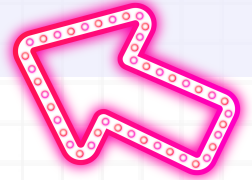
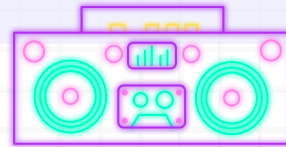
ONGOING ACTIVITIES
