Your kind donations are still very welcome at the Summer Fair tomorrow.

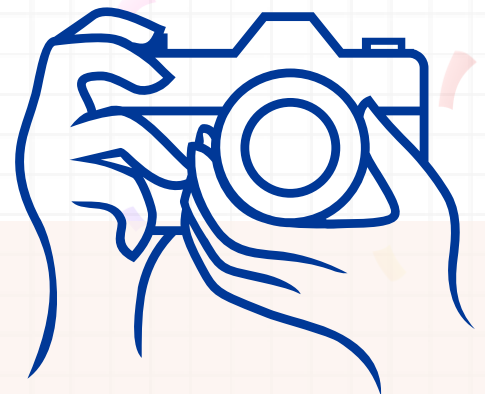
